

Lake County Saddle Horse Presents its First Annual “Cow Pie Bingo”

How to Play “Cow Pie Bingo”

- 1) Buy your ticket!
 - There will be 100 \$5.00 tickets sold with a 50/50 prize of \$250 to the winner.
 - There will be 100 \$25 tickets sold with a 50/50 prize of \$1,250 to the winner.
 - If all the tickets are sold, the committee may elect to sell another set of tickets.
 - There is no age limit or limit on the amount of tickets one can buy.
 - The number on the ticket will be the square number.
 - There will be a 10 X 10 grid in the arena containing numbers 1 through 100. The square numbers will be randomly selected at 11:30 a.m. on August 23, 2009 in the Dunsailin Ring at the Lake County Fairgrounds. (Like square on football boards are selected).
- 2) Come to the Dunsailin Ring on Sunday, August 23, 2009 with your ticket stub or proof of identification. (Winner need not be present to win.) You must pay gate admission to get into the fairgrounds.
- 3) A cow will be placed onto the grid at 12:00 p.m. August 23, 2009.
- 4) Everyone will watch and root the cow on as it decides which square to “deposit” on. The person holding the ticket number that the cow deposits on wins the prize!
- 5) If the cow deposits on a line, the line judge will determine if the majority is on one square over the other to determine the winner or split the prize. If the cow deposits equally on a corner shared by four squares, those ticket holders that are present may elect to split the prize or have a drawing between the four tickets to determine the winner. The line judges’ decision is final!
- 6) If the cow does not co-operate by 1 p.m., a drawing will determine the winner.
- 7) In the event of poor arena conditions due to weather, the tickets will be drawn as a 50/50 raffle to determine the winner.
